Creative Brief

The Theory of Everything (Directed by: James Marsh)

This film is about a student named Stephen Hawking who is quite intelligent. He meets a girl named Jane at school and they get really close. Soon, Stephen learns that he has motor neuron disease, which would eventually affect his entire body. The doctors tell him he only has two years to live. Jane and Stephen get married and have two children. He starts the study of time. Stephen acheives more than he could have ever imagined in his studies. Later, he has an episode and the doctors say there is nothing they can do because they refuse to do a trachotomy. Elaine is Stephen's caretaker. He gets a robotic speech machine and is able to communicate a lot more with his family and friends and writes, A brief history in time. Jane and stephen get a divorce and Jane marries Jonathan. Stephen continues to seek the Theory of Everything.

Color:

I would like to portray this book in a very unique but dramatic way. The color scheme I will use is black and white, with subtle colors of dark blue. The reason is because I feel like black and white gives a very dramatic and real feel. This storyline is very inspiring and motivational and I think the subtle blue hues throughout the book can represent it.

Director & Visual interpretation:

The story ends when Stephen is around the age of 72, and he was diagnosed with the illness at the age of 21. I would like to show time through hours or days on every page of the book. The numbers would be placed in the same place on each spread. Another idea I had was showing time through the long hand of an analog clock. The long hand would continously move throughout each page, so when you flip through the book (the clock part looks like a flip book.) On the last page I would show that he is 72, he lived 49 more years than what the doctor told him when he was 21.

As the director, I will add interesting typographic edits, cut outs, text imagery and possibly even sketches or marks. Typographic edits meaning, like a play on words such as "Black Holes aren't black! And they Explode!" I would use a black background with white text and have the explode repeat multiple times scattered accross the spread. Through the text, I want the audience to feel the emotions that they characters are going through. For example, when Stephen finds out about his disease, he feels angry, sad, and depressed. He doesn't want to talk to anyone or even about it. He only has two years to live. In this case, I would make the words large and cut through them, to show that he is angry. Imagery can also help the audience understand they story and emotions, but imagery through the text (not acutal images). Also, when Stephen get the robotic speech machine, his words would be in all caps, type writer text, so it's distinct compared to the other characters. The way I will show the different characters speaking is by color, Jane would be gray and Stephen would be black. I would only give the main characters a specific color, the other characters can either be labeled or all in the same shade of gray. The story ends when Stephen is around the age of 72, and he was diagnosed with the illness at the age of 21.

Audience:

My audience would be everyone above the age of twelve. I think this storyline and plot is very relatable. We all go through something that is really hard and are able to overcome it with the help of supportive friends and family. I also think it would be easy to understand. Younger than twelve, may not fully grasp the idea of the story or what to get out of it.
